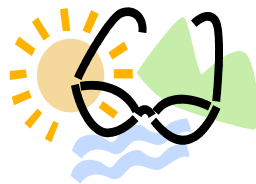

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Dress Code Reminder



As the warm weather approaches please take a moment to review with your child the appropriate clothing to wear in a school setting. Our dress code states that students are not allowed to wear “clothing that causes disruption or disorder on school grounds.” Clothing that falls into this category includes, tank tops with spaghetti straps, midriff baring tops, tube tops and exposed undergarments. Further examples include clothing that advertises or depicts illegal activities such as drug, tobacco and alcohol use. Hats and bandannas are not to be worn inside the school building. Please refer to our student handbook (pg. 8) for the section on dress code. As a guide, shorts and skirts should be at least the length of your child’s index finger when the hand is placed by your child’s side.

In addition, per order of the board of health, appropriate footwear must be worn in the school building at all times. School administrators may require a student to change if they are wearing clothing or footwear that may be seen as a distraction to the educational process. Parental support in regard to this matter would be greatly appreciated.
