

*Fifth Annual Middle School  
Turkey Stroll/Trot  
Wednesday November 22, 2006*

**The Event:** Students, faculty, and staff will walk, jog, or run 1.5 miles around the Russell street campus.

**The Route:** The course will start at the front of the building. Runners will start first. The student body will travel to the Russell Street School along the path between the two buildings. Walkers will circle the track two times (runners 4X) and then walk along the perimeter of the field hockey/baseball field. The group will exit the field area and proceed along the ring road back to the front of the middle school. The final leg is through the temporary parking lot. Students will enter through the side door and proceed back to homerooms. Middle School teachers will direct students along the route and monitor student safety.

**The fee:** There will be no charge for participation in this event. However, students are strongly urged to bring one or more items of non-perishable food that will be donated to Loaves and Fishes for the holiday season. Last year we collected over 3,000 items. Donations may be brought in from November 1 – 8. Please bring items to your homeroom teacher where a tally will be kept. Remember this is a homeroom based competition.

**The Lesson:** Students at all grade levels will be given a math problem related to the walk to be completed over the Thanksgiving break.

N.B. Inclement weather (i.e. a driving cold rain, blizzard, or other **significant** weather event) will force us to cancel the walk. In the past, we have held this event in the snow so please have your children dress warmly with appropriate footwear.
