


## Covid-19 Cases by Age Group

## Case Rates per 100k for the last two weeks




Case rates are highest among people aged 15-19, followed by 10-14 and 20-29


#### Case Rates per 100k over last 6 weeks



Trends for all age groups have declined over the past month (slowing rate of decline among 5-9 and 10-14)



Littleton - Rate 22.0 per 100k (higher than 2 weeks ago)


State, County, and surrounding areas all trended lower






### **How it started**
